2024 GEORGIA GOLDEN OLYMPICS INFORMATION

The 2024 Georgia Golden Olympics Committee extends a personal invitation to you to attend the 40th Georgia Golden Olympics Event. ALL MEN and WOMEN, 50 and OVER, are invited to participate in the Georgia Golden Olympics on September 17-21, 2024 (Tuesday through Saturday) in Warner Robins, GA, hosted by the Warner Robins Parks & Recreation Department.

PURPOSE

By providing the opportunity to participate in a social, competitive, recreational, and athletic events, the Golden Olympics:

- Helps to maintain and improve health and wellness.
- Promotes an interest in lifetime sports, recreation and physical activity.
- Creates an awareness of the abilities and capabilities of older adults.

AGE

- Determined by participant's age as of December 31, 2024.
- All individual events will be held in 5 year age brackets (50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+).
- Age division for doubles and mixed doubles is determined by the youngest partner on December 31, 2024.
- Team sports will be held in the following age categories: 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+. Three on three basketball will have an 80+ division. Age division is determined by the youngest player on team as of December 31, 2024.

CATEGORY

- **STANDING** and **SITTING**: **STANDING** category for all events. **SITTING** for non-national qualifying events. (Note: **SITTING** is designed for those participants whose physical mobility is dependent upon supportive devices such as wheelchairs or walkers).

REGISTRATION FEE

- Registration fee of **\$45 if registered by August 1, 2024 (Late Registration: \$80.00 after August 1, 2024 until August 15, 2024 only)** entitles participant to enter up to three (3) events of their choice with no time conflicts. **"Event" is defined as "one" activity. For example, tennis singles and doubles are two events.**

Participation (not registration) entitles individuals to a T-Shirt, Friday dinner (if indicated on form), lunch on Saturday and medal for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. **The registration fee does not include or entitle one to a t-shirt. Shirts are given to participating athletes only.**

ADDITIONAL FEES

Each additional event over 3 is **\$7.00** per event; **Archery** fee is **\$12.00**; **Bowling** fee is **\$10.00** per event; **Cycling** fee is **\$40.00**; **Golf** fee is **\$30.00** which includes cart and green fees; **Tennis** fee is **\$8.00**; **Racewalk** fee is **\$8.00**; **Softball tournament** fee is **\$50** per team.

FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE FOR ANY REASON AFTER AUGUST 15, 2024.

REGISTRATION

- Register online at the Georgia Golden Olympics website **only if you have previously competed in Georgia.** Go to www.georgiagoldenolympics.org and click on the registration link.
- Others must complete the registration form and mail with proper fees and **age verification** by August 1, 2024.
- **Pickleball players must register through pickleballbrackets.com.**

The liability waiver on the Registration form must be signed and dated by the applicant. Incomplete registrations will be returned and may be resubmitted within five days of notification.

COMBINED/CANCELED EVENTS

- Olympic officials reserve the right to cancel events or combine age groups with insufficient numbers registered.

FORFEIT TIME

- Athletes forfeit the right to participate if not present at an event 15 minutes **PRIOR** to start time for roll call.

PROOF OF AGE

- Proof of age is required if you **HAVE NOT** participated in the Georgia Golden Olympics since 1993.
- Acceptable proof of age includes copy of an ID such as driver's license, birth certificate, passport, military record.
- **Registrations without acceptable proof of age will be returned** and will delay the registration process.

EVENT CHANGES, ADDITIONS, NOTES

- **Most events will be held at the new North Houston Sports Complex. Please see schedule for specifics.**
- **Swimming will be held at the Tommy Stalnaker Aquatic Center in Warner Robins. See page 7 for exact address.**
- **Disc Golf and 1 mile Run have been added for 2024. Both events are open national qualifying events.**
- **Billiards is now an open National Qualifying event.**
- Only (5) **swimming** events allowed.
- Only two (2) **tennis** events allowed.
- Athletes may **not** compete in both **Horseshoe Tournament** and **Horseshoe Toss**.
- **Race walkers may not compete in power walking events and vice versa.**
- **Race walkers, runners, 1500M and 5K Power Walkers may not compete in the ½ mile walk.**
- **Team bowling must have 6 teams or event will be canceled. A team is 4 members.**
- **Doubles and mixed doubles athletes MUST provide their own partner and each athlete must register.**
- **Pickleball players must register through pickleballbrackets.com. Register for all other events with this form or online .**
- **No changes in team rosters after August 15, 2024.**
- **Athletes are responsible for knowing the rules regulations, physical requirements and abilities needed for their event.**

- Track shoes or running shoes only may be used for track and field events. No other sports cleats i.e., football, baseball may be worn.
- Team Managers/Captains Each team member should register and managers should submit roster for team. Print roster from www.georgiagoldenolympics.org
Managers should submit team fee if applicable.
NO TEAM ROSTER CHANGES ALLOWED AFTER AUGUST 15, 2024.

- Medals will be given at the completion of each event.

RULES AND POLICIES

- All events are governed by the National Governing Board rules for each event. Exceptions are noted in the Georgia Golden Olympics Rule Book. A copy of the Georgia Rule Book can be ordered for \$10.00 from: GGO Rules, PO Box 958, Winder, GA 30680. The rulebook is also available on the website: www.georgiagoldenolympics.org
- During an event, all appeals for official interpretation shall be made to the Event Director for that specific event. If the Event Director needs assistance or a controversy occurs, the Rules Committee will render a final decision. **Appeals must be filed immediately or the right to appeal is forfeited.**

SCHEDULE CONFLICTS

- Due to the number of events, there are time frames when more than one event is scheduled. Athletes may register in only one event per time frame **unless otherwise noted. It is the athlete’s responsibility to check for time conflicts.** Registrations with schedule conflicts will be returned or GGO staff will make the event choice.

RAIN PLAN

- In case of inclement weather, unusual or extenuating circumstances, Georgia Golden Olympics officials reserve the right to **cancel events completely** or postpone events to a different time than scheduled.

FOOD, FUN, AWARDS DINNER, DANCING

- The Parade of Athletes and Torch lighting will be held at the Wellston Center, 55 Maple St., on Thursday evening, September 19, 2024. Please plan to attend and enjoy the Food Truck Roundup next door at Perkins Park. Food vouchers will be provided.
- Awards Dinner: all athletes are invited to Dinner, Friday, September 20, 2024, 6:30 pm, the Wellston Center, 155 Maple Street, WR. The theme is “Team Spirit”. Don your favorite sports team gear and join the excitement. Immerse yourself in Team Spirit as you enjoy a wonderful dinner, hit the dance floor and capture the fun in your team colors at the lively photo booth. An evening of sports themed joy you will not want to miss. Please indicate on the registration form if you will be attending the dinner. Additional guest tickets are \$15.00.
